Fellowship application guidelines

The application should contain a cover page and

- a summary of preliminary work, state of the art and a project description
- prerequisites for the project
- a detailed summary how the grant will be utilized
- a CV of the main applicant
- a separate summary for overhead presentation
- a letter of reference from the supervisor

The **cover page** should include:

- Name, institutional address and contact data of the main applicant.
- Title of the project
- Short summary of the research project (max. 500 characters including spaces).

Project description:

Describe your own preliminary work and the current state of the art.

Line out briefly and concisely the goals of your thesis project, the intended methodology and how to achieve these goals (maximum 5.000 characters including spaces). Please indicate also the intended total project duration.

Prerequisites:

List all prerequisites needed and/or already available for the proposed project, i.e. available equipment, contribution of the applicant's institution, collection permits, visa etc.

Grant utilization:

Describe precisely for which kind of investments you want to use the fellowship including the estimated costs for each position. No restrictions are made by the G.F.P. except that the utilization is limited to your thesis project and must not be used to cover salaries.

The grant can be used for lab equipment and consumables, investments, travel expenses, maintenance of equipment needed for the project, publication fees,

expenses for field research etc.

At the end of the project duration, a detailed financial settlement has to be provided.

Curriculum vitae

Tabular CV of the applicant including a publication list (if applicable).

Letter of reference

The supervisor of the applicant should provide a letter of reference including a statement that the applicant is affiliated to his/hers research institution, is conducting a thesis on carnivorous plants and that the fellowship will be used accordingly to these guidelines.

Illustrated summary

Please provide a separate illustrated summary of your proposal on one or two slides for overhead presentation (pptx and/or pdf format).

These slides will be used to present the project to the G.F.P. board assembly.
