The German Carnivorous Plants Association (Gesellschaft für Fleischfressende Pflanzen im deutschsprachigen Raum e.V. – G.F.P.) welcomes applications for the support of **habitat conservation projects**.

Grant description:

The G.F.P. is a non-profit NGO. According to its statutes, it promotes knowledge and information about carnivorous plants and their horticulture, assists public institutions such as universities and botanical gardens in their efforts related to carnivorous plants and supports site preservation and conservation projects.

The **habitat conservation fund 2021** is intended to support measurements aiming at protecting or maintaining habitats of carnivorous plants. It covers up 15.000 €. The fund can be applied to any aspect of habitat conservation. The G.F.P. may shorten the requested amount in order to be able to fund more than one project.

Applications can be submitted by public institutions or NGOs such as national park administrations, nature conservation authorities or similar. The grant is transferred singularly to the institutional account and must be exclusively used for the requested purpose. Cash payments and transfers to private persons are excluded. Allocation of the grant is subject to the approval of the G.F.P. board assembly.

Application and deadline:

Applications should be prepared according to the preparation guideline and must be submitted by email in PDF format to the president of the G.F.P, Dr. Thomas Gronemeyer (vorsitzender@carnivoren.org).

The advisory panel of the G.F.P. will evaluate all incoming applications and promote the most promising projects to the G.F.P. board assembly for final decision. Application deadline is the 1st of May 2021.

Grant utilization:

The grant can be requested for all aspects related to habitat conservation. These include acquisition of land, acquisition of material, equipment for maintenance, costs for approval procedures, salaries for temporary staff etc. Running costs and salaries must not be covered with the fund.

Prerequisites:

The applicant agrees to provide an illustrated summary article describing the funded project (in English or German) for the "Taublatt", the journal of the G.F.P The applicant is furthermore invited (but not engaged) to present the funded project either on the annual general assembly of the G.F.P or the European Exchange and Exhibition (EEE) conference. The G.F.P. is able to allocate travel funding upon request. Funding from the G.F.P. should be mentioned in the acknowledgement of any publication resulting from the funded project.
